It's a school document outlining rules and procedures for responding to harm against you or another child. It includes information about your rights, where to seek help, and how to respond when witnessing violence.

# GOOD ATMOSPHERE AT SHOOL



In our school, you can feel safe. We know how to respond to violence!

### **BODILY INTEGRITY**



No one has the right to violate your bodily integrity without your consent. Hugging, holding, stroking, tickling, and touching.

### YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO RESPECT!



No one should pull you, humiliate you, or embarrass you.

### SAFE INTERNET



No one can ask you for your photos or videos. Report anything inappropriate you see on the Internet.

### **CYBERBULLYING**



Cyberbullying is any action intended to demean or intimidate another person. This can include verbal aggression, insults, and unauthorized sharing of photos.

### REMEMBER!



No one should record or photograph you without your consent. You have the right to privacy. Your consent matters!

### **ALWAYS TAKE ACTION!**

- if someone is harming you, using violence against you,
- if you witness violence or if someone is harmed,
- you have the right to speak out about inappropriate behavior of others, including family members.



## WHO CAN HELP YOU AT SCHOOL?

### If someone is being harmed, report it to:

- the form tutor,
- the school principal,
- school counselor, psychologist,
   special education teacher,
- a trusted school staff member.
